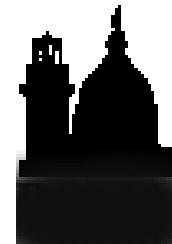

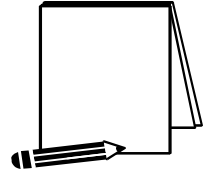
WHAT DO I GET FOR MY DUES?
